Please note that all information **MUST** be completed before Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> May. Anyone who has not completed the sign on and scrutineering form before this date may not be granted access to Kirkistown. Random spot checks will be carried out by scrutineers during the event.

We have now allocated all available space so we must remind you that you **MUST** only attend the event alone. Anyone who arrives that has not been allocated within the 100 will **NOT** be allowed access to the event. Once everyone has arrived the gates will be closed for the duration of the event.
